

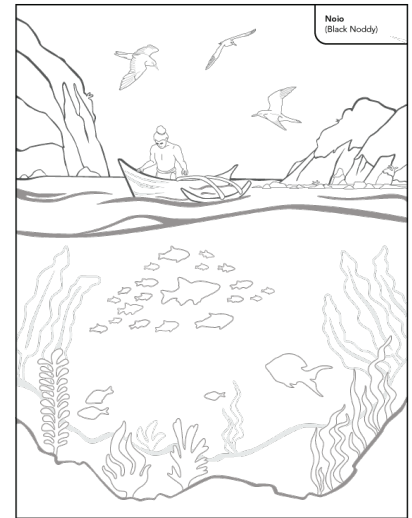
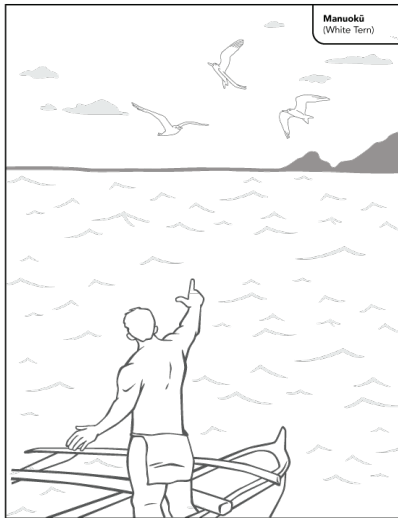
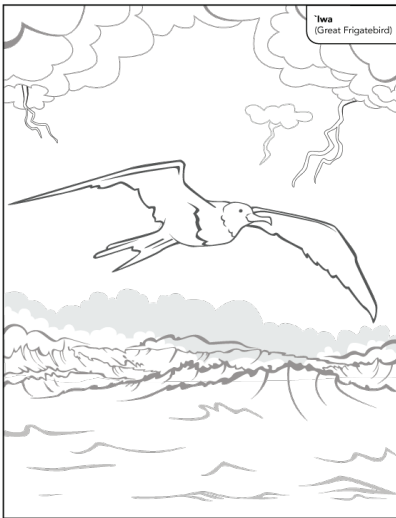
LAND-BASED SEABIRDS IN HAWAI'I COLORING PAGES

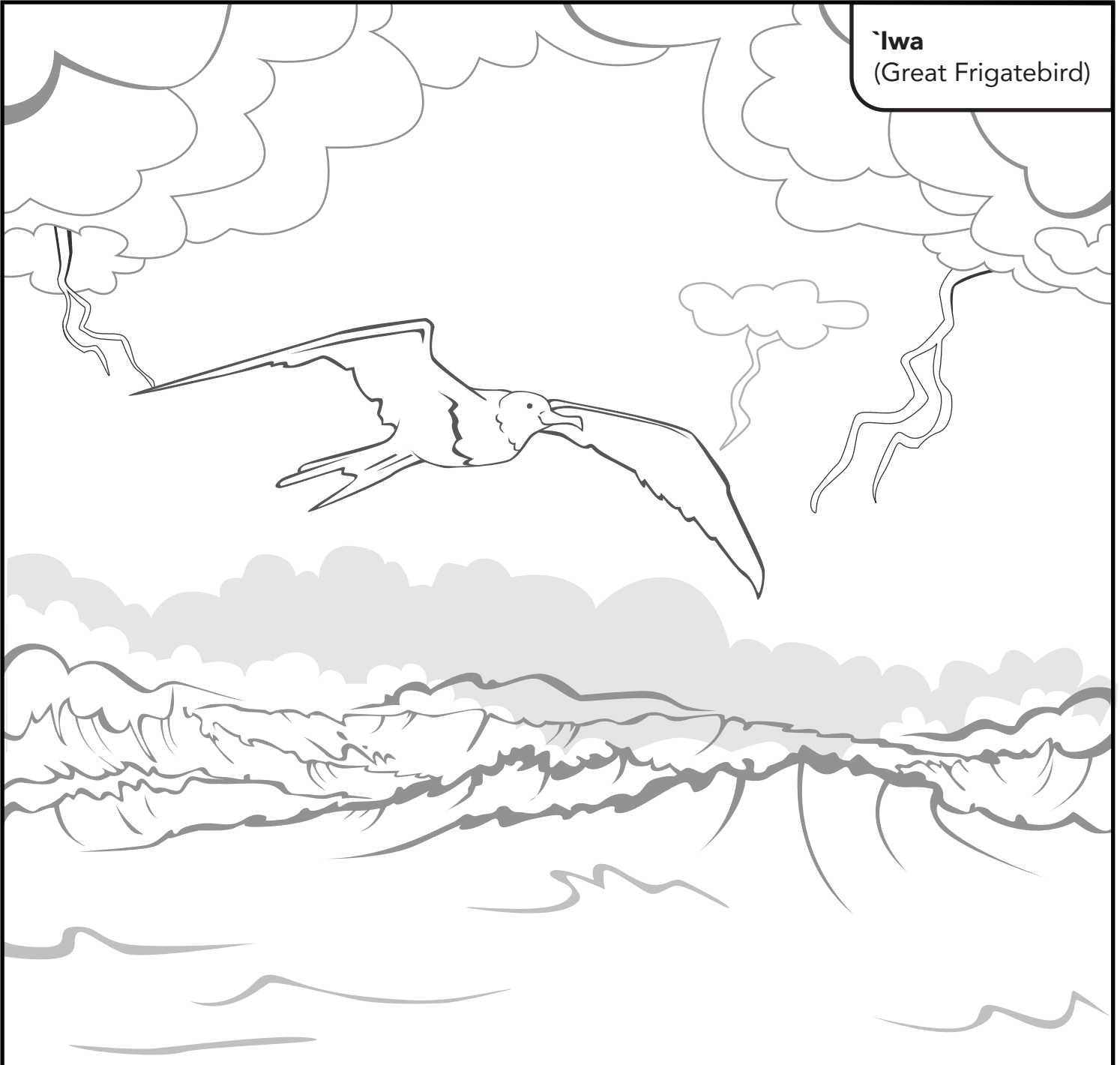

(Great Frigatebird)

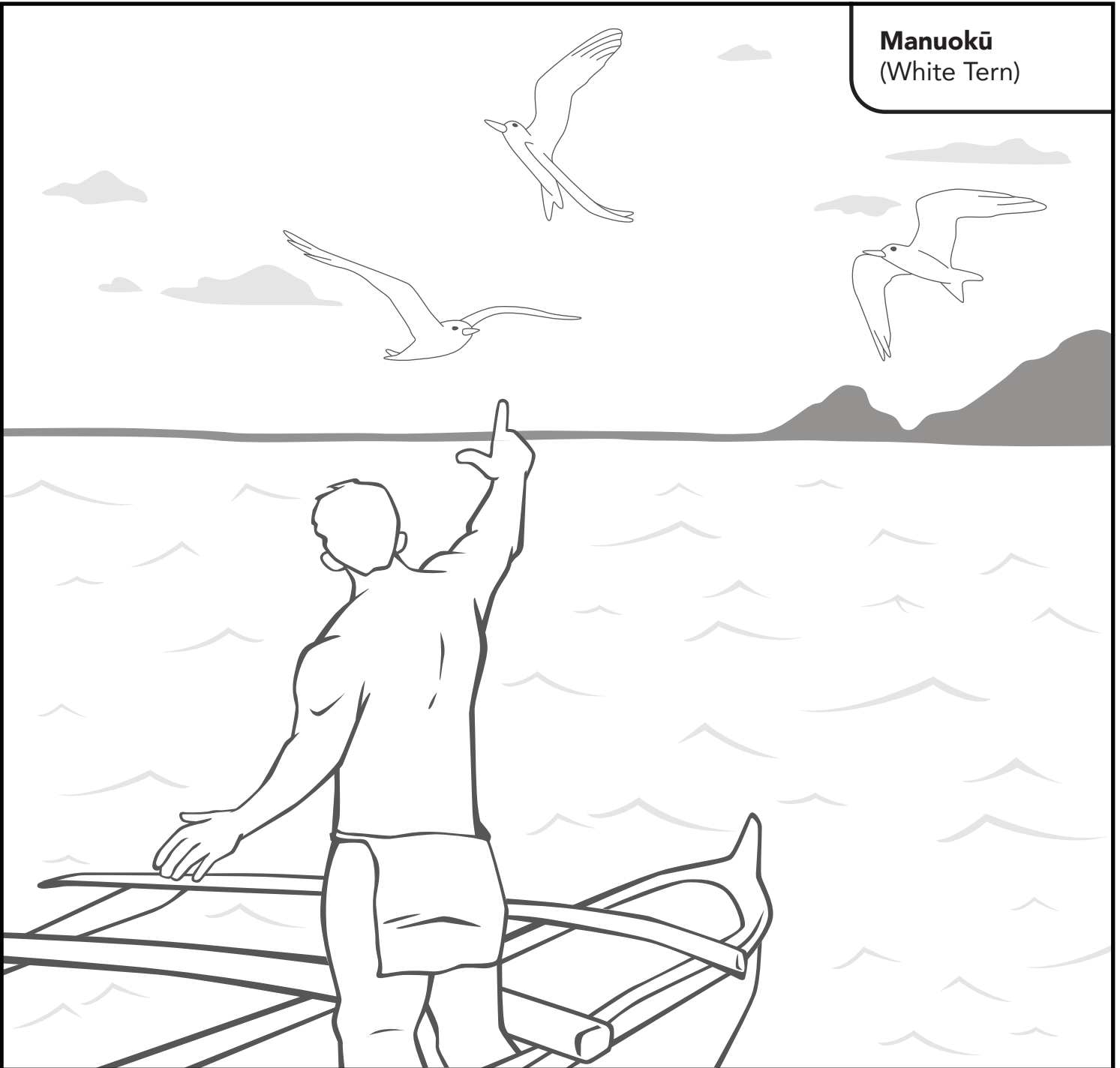


When wayfinders see a group of 'Iwa near shore,

(White Tern)

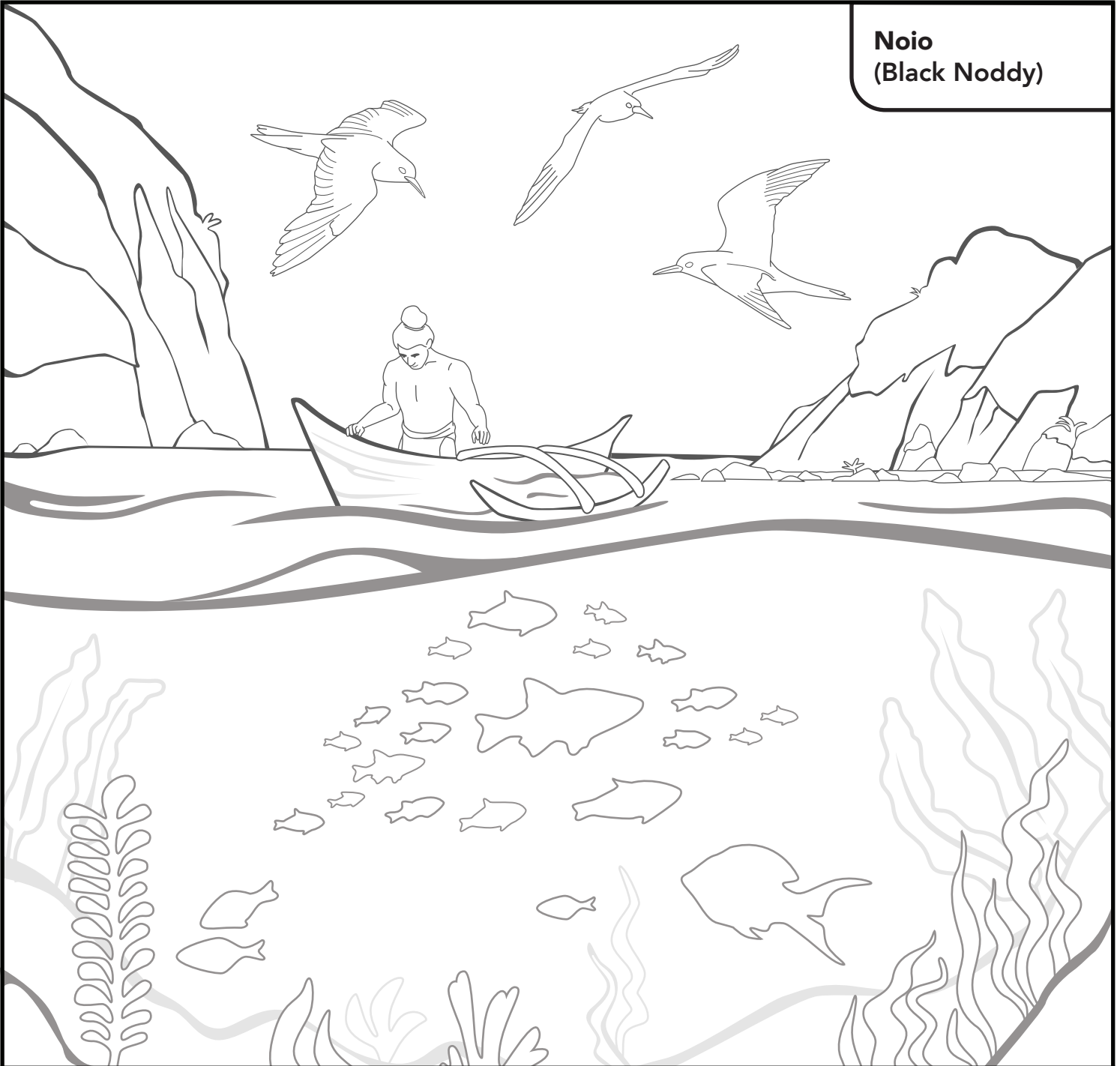


**When wayfinders see a group of Manuokū,
